HHT affects 1 in 5000 and can cause a number of health problems including,

Nosebleeds, Telangiectasia or red/purple dots on the skin, mouth or tongue

Gastric and intestinal bleeding,

Pulmonary, Liver and Brain AVMs

Pulmonary Hypertension

Anaemia

Untreated pulmonary AVMs can lead to infections and abscesses in the brain, strokes and other life threatening conditions.
